





Library Resources

GIL-Find Catalog — **GIL-Find** is the library catalog, a database of all of the books, eBooks, streaming films, journals, and other materials owned by College of Coastal Georgia.

Each student has a GIL-Find account for requesting and renewing materials. Use GIL-Find to find books on our library shelves as well as eBooks and journals in print and digital format.

Coastal students, faculty, and staff also can check out materials from other institutions within the **University System of Georgia**. (This service is called **GIL Express**.) Request materials through your GIL-Find account. (Switch from College of Coastal Georgia to University System of Georgia using the search box drop-down menu.)

GALILEO — **GALILEO** is a portal to more than 100 databases of periodicals and scholarly journals, as well as eBooks and eJournals, maps, newspapers, photographs, historic documents, streaming films, and more. Find the link on the library's webpage

Course Reserves — Course Reserves are materials your instructor has set aside for your class. They are located at the Help Desk and are arranged by Call Number. Check your syllabus for the titles of these materials or find them in GIL-Find by title, author, instructor, or course. Course Reserves may be checked out for two hours for use inside the library.

Interlibrary Loan — ILL is a service available for borrowing books and articles that are not available at Coastal Georgia or within the University System of Georgia (GIL-Find/GIL-Express), in GALILEO, or on the internet. Use the request forms on the library's webpage or in GALILEO. Contact Karen Haven at khaven@ccga.edu for more info.

Research Guides — **Research Guides or LibGuides** are webpages curated by librarians. Guides focus on specific courses, programs, or on general interest topics. Some offer tips on research and other academic topics.
